











Grades

- ★ Grades are issued on a semester basis. Students will receive first semester grades in December and second semester grades in June (this will go on your transcript forever!!!)
- ★ Students and parents should check their grades regularly on Aeries

Course requirements for admissions to a CSU or UC pass with a C or better

Must complete 15 "A-G" courses by the end of the Senior Year; must complete 11 "A-G" courses by the end of 11th grade for UC

**Some colleges desire additional courses in some subject requirements. Students should visit the college website to determine additional classes desired by the specific college.

Gold Cap

Students who complete the A-G university requirements with at least a C or better in all required classes will receive a special gold cap to wear at graduation!

- ★ Sophomores can only Opt out of 1, 2, 7 and 8th period

Attendance

• All students must have "less than 30 period absences" in order to maintain their eligibility to go off campus, along with being on track to graduate! Any senior with more than 30 PERIOD absences their senior year will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.



 Excused absences are: Medical appointments, subpoenas to court, a funeral for an immediate family member, and any school activity that you are participating in. Senior students get 2 days excused for college visits.

*Students must have all their notes and verifications turned in within 5 days upon your return to school. If you were marked absent but were in class the attendance office has attendance slips that you will need to pick up and have your teacher sign and then return to the office. <u>Attendance slips will only be accepted and cleared within two week of the marked absence</u>.



- If you have more than 30 period absences you will be meeting with an AP and assigned Saturday School. You can not participate in graduation ceremonies or extra curricular activities if you are not meeting the district attendance policy.
- Arriving Late = No admittance- must be in the cafeteria prior to the start of the session.
- Leaving Early = NO CREDIT
- Each Saturday school session clear 4 missing PERIODS (1 full day)
- Bring Chromebook and plenty of homework to work on.
- Disciplinary issues = asked to leave and NO CREDIT issued
- Breakfast snack is provided. You may bring your own food. Only bottle water to drink.

Chromebook & Tech Agreement

- Bring your Chromebook fully charged everyday to school.
- Turn in your signed Tech Agreement ASAP. Students without a Tech Agreement will be locked out soon.
- You have a \$25 lease fee that includes insurance needs to be paid every year.

<u>Hotspots</u>

- If you need a hotspot please see Mrs. Cortez in the AP office.
- A signed parent agreement is needed before receiving a hot spot.
- If you have hotspot and no longer need it please return it to Mrs. Castro in the AP office.







Dress Code

- Shirts must have a 1" strap
- Short length within the bounds of decency

- Solid color beanies only from November 1 to March 1

- Pants must fit at the waist

*No "Cookies" "Chapo" "Backwoods" "Shorties and 40's"etc.




ID Cards

Tardy Policy

- 1st Tardy: Warning
- 2nd Tardy: Warning
- 3rd Tardy: 15-Minute lunch detention.
- **4th Tardy:** Meet with counselor and 15-Minute lunch detention.
- **5th Tardy:** Meet with assistant principal and 30-Minute lunch detention.
- **6 or more Tardies:** Meet with Assistant Principal and parent, and Saturday School assigned.





Bathroom Policy (20/20)

Schoolwide Policy:

First 20 minutes and last 20 minutes of class:

Students are not permitted to use bathroom



Bathroom Passes:

Red Zone= 50 building/70 building/80 building/100 building Gold Zone= 200, 300, 400 building White Zone= 500 building, 600 building, Homework Lab, PE classes



Cell Phone Policy

Electronic devices may be used on campus only during non-class times. Students found using their electronic devices during class time without teacher permission, may have their device or phone confiscated and/or be subject to disciplinary action.

Any student who violates the Electronic Communications Device Policy is subject to the following:

1st Offense - Warning, ask student to put phone away

2nd Offense - Confiscate phone, give back to student at the end of the period, teacher calls home **3rd Offense** - Confiscate phone, turn in to admin office, student pick up at the end of the day, teacher/admin call home

4th Offense - Confiscate phone, turn in to admin office, parent pick up at the end of the day, admin calls home

5th Offense - Confiscate phone, turn in to admin office, parent pick up at the end of the day, additional consequence given to student





FDA- Fight/Drug/Alcohol Policy

- Zero tolerance for this behavior.
- If you fight on campus here is what happens:
- Arrested by Tulare Police Department
- Suspension plus a rehabilitation plan to help stop this from happening again
- If you hit 3 fights between now and graduation, you WILL be expelled
- If you have violations for Drugs or Alcohol here is what happens:
- Suspension plus a rehabilitation plan to help stop this from happening again
- Ticket to probation
- Automatic Drug counseling assigned

Please come see Admin and/or your Counselors if you are having problems, so we can help you solve them before you build a discipline record!!!

Physical Information/Sports

- Online registration with Family ID every year (It's only good for one year) Turn in drug testing consent every year
- Proof of athletic & activity/club registration form every year
- All of this goes to nurse before you can start practicing
- Attendance on game days
- Grades/Eligibility
- Tom Yost Award & Participation in Athletics







Career Center/Work Permits

- Work Permits Guidelines:
- Must have established in the previous grading period a GPA of no less than 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must maintain minimum progress towards graduation shall be taken by the student and based on the following: 55 units by the end of 9th grade; 110 units by the end of 10th grade; and 165 units by the end of 11th grade.
- Must maintain a minimum of 85% attendance rate in ALL classes.
